## Artistic Gymnastics - By The Numbers

RIO DE JANEIRO – By the numbers for artistic gymnastics which begins on Saturday, 6 August at Rio Olympic Arena.

**933** - number of medals awarded in artistic gymnastics in Olympic history.

**182** - number of Olympic medals won by Soviet Union in artistic gymnastics, which is the most by a single National Olympic Committee. USA is next with 102 medals.

**18** - With a total of 18 Olympic medals, Larissa LATYNINA (URS) is the most decorated female Olympian ever (in any sport).

**14** - At the Montreal 1976 Olympic Games, Nadia COMANECI (ROU) became the youngest individual all-around Olympic champion ever at 14 years old.

**10** - percentage of gold medals won by USA (33 of 323).

**10** - At the Montreal Games, COMANECI became the first gymnast in Olympic history to be awarded a perfect 10 for her performance on the uneven bars.

**9** - Only swimmer Michael PHELPS (USA, 18) has won more Olympic gold medals than Larissa LATYNINA (URS, 9).

**6** - Oksana CHUSOVITINA (UZB) and Jordan JOVTCHEV (BUL) are the only two gymnasts who have competed in a record six different Olympic Games.

**5** - Heikki SAVOLAINEN (FIN) is the only athlete who has grabbed a medal in artistic gymnastics at five different Olympic Games.

**3** - Epke ZONDERLAND (NED) became the first gymnast to perform three consecutive flight elements on the horizontal bar, when he took gold at the London 2012 Olympic Games.

**1** - At the 2012 Games, Arthur ZANETTI (BRA) won the men's rings event to hand Brazil its first ever Olympic medal in gymnastics.
