

Bundesliga Review - Saturday 26 August 2017

Werder Bremen - Bayern München 0-2

- Bayern have now won their last 14 Bundesliga encounters with Werder, extending their longest top flight winning run against single opponents.
- Werder failed to score in their first two league matches of the season for the first time since 1999/2000.
- Manuel Neuer won his 223rd Bundesliga match, equalling Uli Stein in joint-third place for most among goalkeepers, only behind Oliver Kahn (310) and Sepp Maier (249).
- Robert Lewandowski has now scored 12 times against Werder Bremen in the Bundesliga. He has only scored more against FC Augsburg (16) and VfL Wolfsburg (16).
- With his second goal, Lewandowski equalled Mario Gomez on 154 goals as top scorer of the Bundesliga among active players.

Eintracht Frankfurt - VfL Wolfsburg 0-1

- Wolfsburg have won three consecutive Bundesliga fixtures against Frankfurt for the second time, after their first three top flight encounters in 1998-1999.
- Frankfurt failed to score in their opening two Bundesliga matches of a season for the first time in their club history.
- Daniel Didavi has now scored in each of his four Bundesliga appearances against Frankfurt (total four goals). He has not scored more BL goals against any other opponents (also four against Wolfsburg and Dortmund).

Bayer 04 Leverkusen - TSG 1899 Hoffenheim 2-2

- Leverkusen remained winless in their opening two matches of a Bundesliga season for the first time since 2007/08 when they finished in seventh place.
- They failed to win their opening home match of a Bundesliga season for the first time since 2010/11, when they were beaten 6-3 by Gladbach in their home opener.
- Only Javier Hernández (28) has scored more Bundesliga goals for Leverkusen since 2014/15 than Karim Bellarabi (21).
- Andrej Kramaric joined Vedad Ibisevic (2008/09), Sejard Salihovic (2011/12), Anthony Modeste (2013/14) and Mark Uth (2016/17) as players to score in each of the first two BL matches of the season for Hoffenheim.

FC Augsburg - Borussia Mönchengladbach 2-2

- Augsburg remained unbeaten in all seven Bundesliga home matches against Gladbach - they have not played more than five top flight home fixtures without losing against any other opponents.
- Alfred Finnbogason scored after 34 seconds, the fastest goal for Augsburg in their Bundesliga history. Their previous record fastest goal was also scored by Finnbogason, after 46 seconds against Wolfsburg on 23 April 2016.
- Oscar Wendt is the only player to have scored for Gladbach in each of the previous six seasons for the team in the Bundesliga, starting his scoring streak in 2012/13. He scored one, two or three goals in each season.

VfB Stuttgart - 1. FSV Mainz 05 1-0

- Stuttgart won their first Bundesliga match since 5 March 2017 (5-1 v Hoffenheim), ending a losing run of seven top flight fixtures.
- Holger Badstuber scored only his second Bundesliga goal, after his goal for Bayern München against Gladbach on 4 December 2009. He ended a run of 115 Bundesliga appearances without a goal.

Borussia Dortmund - Hertha BSC 2-0

- Borussia Dortmund are now unbeaten in their last 39 Bundesliga home matches (W31-D7-L0), the fifth longest streak in Bundesliga history.
- They have won their first two matches of a Bundesliga season for the third time in the last 15 seasons (2013/14 and 2015/16).
- BVB have kept a clean sheet in their opening two matches of a Bundesliga season for the third time, after 2001/02 and 2015/16.
- Peter Bosz became the first ever Dutch coach in the Bundesliga to win his first two matches as a manager in the league.
- Pierre-Emerick Aubameyang scored in each of Dortmund's first two Bundesliga fixtures this season. He was already the only player to have done so since 2006/07 as he achieved this in 2015/16 as well.
- Nuri Sahin (1 goal/1 assist) was directly involved in multiple goals in a single Bundesliga match for the first time since 27 April 2013, when he also scored and assisted once in BVB's 2-1 victory at Fortuna Düsseldorf.
