

Bundesliga Review - Saturday 3 November 2018

FC Bayern München - SC Freiburg 1-1

- Bayern have now dropped 10 points. Their 20 points after 10 matches is their lowest return at this stage of the season since 2010/11, when they had 15 at this juncture.
- With 16 wins and three draws, FC Bayern München have never lost a Bundesliga home match against SC Freiburg.
- FC Bayern München are winless in their last two BL home matches (W0-D2-L1), since a 3-1 victory over Bayer 04 Leverkusen on 15 September.
- Bayern have failed to win three top flight home matches in a row for the first time since September 2010 (W0-D2-L1) under manager Louis van Gaal.
- Serge Gnabry scored his first goal for Bayern in the Bundesliga in his ninth appearance for the club. For Hoffenheim he scored twice in his first nine BL appearances but finished on 10 goals last season. For Werder Bremen he scored four times in his first nine BL in 2016/17.
- Lucas Höler scored his third Bundesliga goal. He scored in the 89' minute, his earliest goal in the BL so far after scoring in 90+2' and 90+4'.

FC Schalke 04 - Hannover 96 3-1

- Hannover have won only one of their opening 10 matches of a BL season for the first time since 2006/07 (W1-D4-L5). That run included a 2-1 away defeat at Schalke 04
- Nabil Bentaleb and Breel Embolo became the first Schalke players with multiple BL goals this season.
- Die Königsblauen have converted 12 of their last 13 BL penalties.
- Hendrik Weydandt scored his second BL goal of the season and his first since the opening matchday.
- Breel Embolo scored his second goal of the BL season and his first since 15 September when he netted in a 2-1 defeat at Gladbach.
- Mark Uth scored his first goal of the season in the Bundesliga. Last year, he already scored five times before November finishing as top scorer of Hoffenheim last season (14 goals).
- FC Schalke 04 have now lost just one of their last 15 home matches against Hannover 96 in the Bundesliga (W11-D3-L1), a 2-1 defeat on 28 August 2010. Konstantin Rausch and Mohammed Abdellaoue scored for the visitors. Jermaine Jones netted for the hosts.

Bayer 04 Leverkusen - TSG 1899 Hoffenheim 1-4

- Hoffenheim have claimed three consecutive away wins for the first time in the top flight.
- Hoffenheim score four goals in back-to-back BL matches for the third time after September 2008 and September 2009.
- Reiss Nelson scored his fifth BL goal this term. Only one foreign player managed more as a teenager in a single campaign. France's Ousmana Dembélé scored six as a teenager in 2016/17.
- For the first time in his career, Karim Bellarabi has scored in three successive BL appearances.
- Vincenzo Grifo scored from the spot. Hoffenheim have converted 11 of their last 12 BL penalties.
- Joelinton became the third Brazilian to score twice in a BL match for Hoffenheim after Carlos Eduardo (once) and Roberto Firmino (four times).

FC Augsburg - 1. FC Nürnberg 2-2

- For only the second time Augsburg avoided defeat at home against Nürnberg in Bundesliga was on 12 February 2012, when this exact fixture ended goalless.
- Augsburg scored from a direct free kick in the Bundesliga for the first time in over a year when Philipp Max scored at Eintracht Frankfurt
- The last Augsburg player to score a direct free kick at home in the BL was Tobias Werner on 1 Feb 2015 against Hoffenheim.

- 1. FC Nürnberg are now winless in their last 11 Bundesliga away matches (W0-D2-L9), since a 1-0 win at FC Augsburg on 16 February 2014.
- Nürnberg's last such away winless run in the Bundesliga was a streak of 12 from September 2007 to March 2008.
- Alfred Finnbogason scored his sixth goal this campaign in his fifth appearance. He extended the record for most BL goals for Augsburg to 28.

VfL Wolfsburg - Borussia Dortmund 0-1

- Dortmund remain the only unbeaten team in the Bundesliga this season.
- Dortmund are unbeaten in their opening 10 matches of a Bundesliga campaign for the first time since 2002/03, when they suffered their first defeat in their 12th fixture, 2-1 at Bayern.
- Dortmund have won three successive Bundesliga away fixtures for the first time since February to March 2016.
- Marco Reus scored his sixth BL goal of the season, just one shy of his tally from both last season and the one before.
- Reus has only netted more Bundesliga goals against Mainz (11) and Werder Bremen (11) than against Wolfsburg (10).

Hertha BSC - RB Leipzig

- RB Leipzig are unbeaten in their last nine Bundesliga matches (W5-D4-L0), since a 4-1 loss at Borussia Dortmund in the opening matchround of this season.
- Leipzig are currently on a club record run of four successive Bundesliga fixtures without a goal conceded.
- Timo Werner scored a brace. He has now scored a brace in each of the last three matches he netted in the Bundesliga.
- Since joining Leipzig in 2016/17, Werner has scored 40 Bundesliga goals, at least 10 more than any other German player in this span.
- Matheus Cunha scored his first league goal since 19 May 2018 when he scored a hat-trick for Sion against Thun in the Swiss top flight.
